# PARIS, BELGIUM AND NORTH-EAST FRANCE

FRANCE, BELGIUM

**DAY 1** / Australia - France **B**Depart Australia on your flights to France.

### DAY 2 / Paris BD

Upon arrival, transfer to your accommodation in central Paris. Spend the day exploring the French capital. Visit the Eiffel Tower and the Champ de Mars, before continuing on to the Place de l'Etoile and the Arc de Triomphe. From here, walk down the Champs-Elysées, to the Place de la Concorde and the Jardin des Tuileries.

### DAY 3 / Paris BD

Make your way to the Louvre Museum for a tour of the collection. This afternoon, travel through 2000 years of Parisian history with a holographic Victor Hugo as your guide during the "Explore Paris" show, which also includes a set of five short films with a Parisian flavour. Continue exploring the 9th Arrondissement, visiting the Opéra Garnier and les Grands Magasins of Printemps and Galeries Lafayette.

### DAY 4 / Paris BD

Make your way to the docks of the Bâteaux Parisiens this morning and enjoy a 1-hour cruise on the Seine. Tour l'Ile de la Cité and visit Ste Chapelle. You may decide to climb Notre Dame and visit its gargoyles! 3rd night's accommodation in Paris

### DAY 5 / Paris BD

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of Montmartre. Visit the Place du Tertre, heart of the artists' quartier, and the basilica Sacré Coeur. Continue by metro to the Père Lachaise cemetery and explore the tomb stones and memorials as a group. If time permits, visit the Place des Vosges, the Pompidou Centre and the shops in Les Halles.

4th night's accommodation in Paris

**DAY 6** / The Somme **30** This morning, leave Paris for the



Somme. Explore the World War I battlefields in Beaumont Hamel, the Park of Newfoundland and Thiépval. Transfer to Villers- Bretonneux and visit the Australian Museum and Grave of the Unknown Australian soldier.

### DAY 7 / Amiens, Bruges BD

This morning, visit the town of Amiens and its famous cathedral, France's largest. Continue on to Belgium. Arrive in Bruges, known as "the Northern Venice", and enjoy a boat tour on the canals. Spend free time in this beautiful Belgian town before taking a guided tour of a local chocolate factory and museum.

### DAY 8 / Bruxelles, Reims **B D**

Transfer to Bruxelles for a free morning in the Belgian capital. This afternoon, travel to the Waterloo Visitor Centre. After your visit, transfer to Reims.

## DAY 9 / Reims, Strasbourg **B D**

Spend a free morning in Reims. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame, where Charles VII was crowned King of France in 1429. Stop at one of France's most famous Champagne cellars for a tour before travelling on to the Alsatian capital.

### DAY 10 / Strasbourg BD

This morning, enjoy a guided tour of Strasbourg. Spend a free afternoon exploring the city as a group. You might like to visit Petite France with its half-timbered houses and the Cathedral of Notre Dame, famous for its 12th century stained-glass windows and astronomical clock.

### DAY 11 / Alsace BD

Enjoy a coach tour through the Route des Vins. Stop in the pretty mediaeval towns of Obernai and Damach la Ville, arriving at the famous chateau of Haut Koenigsbourg in the early afternoon. Continue on to the beautiful village of Riquewhir. After visiting the town, drive to Colmar for dinner and accommodation.

### DAY 12 / Colmar, Dijon BD

Spend a free morning exploring the beautiful cobbled streets of Colmar, built in the authentic Alsatian style during the Middle Ages and the Renaissance. This afternoon, transfer to Dijon.

### DAY 13 / Dijon BD

This morning, enjoy a guided tour of Dijon, home to Dijon mustard and the powerful Dukes of Burgundy in the Middle Ages. This afternoon, visit Semur-en-Auxois, a medieval town surrounded by ramparts, and Flavigny-sur-Ozerain, where the movie "Chocolat" was filmed. Return to Dijon. 2nd night's accommodation in Dijon

### DAY 14 / Fontainebleau, Paris 🛛 🖸

This morning, depart Dijon for Paris. En route, stop in Fontainebleau and visit the royal palace. Arrive in Paris in the afternoon.
