DAY 1 / Australia - Germany

Depart Australia on your flight to Germany.

DAY 2 / Rhine Valley **D**

Upon arrival in Frankfurt, transfer by coach to Rudesheim am Rhein. Wander down the famous Drosselgasse to the river and enjoy a Rhine River cruise to St Goarshausen. Return by coach to your accommodation in Frankfurt.

DAY 3 / Frankfurt am Main **B D**

Enjoy a guided tour of the city. The afternoon is free for you to explore Frankfurt as a group. Visit Goethe's birthplace, the Old Opera House or one of the 14 museums, located in waterfront villas dating from the 19th century.

DAY 4 / Würzburg **B D**

Depart Frankfurt for the Baroque City of Würzburg this morning. Enjoy a guided tour of the Altstadt, including a visit to the UNESCO World Heritage listed site "Residenz". Walk up to the fortress Marienberg in the afternoon for beautiful views of the town.

DAY 5 / Fulda, Eisenach **B D**

After breakfast, transfer to Fulda. Explore the town at your own pace, including a visit to the Stadtschloss and its gardens. Continue on to Eisenach in the afternoon. Wander around this small town on the edge of the Thuringian Forest or visit the UNESCO World Heritage listed site Wartburg Castle.

DAY 6 / Erfurt **B D**

Travel to the Thuringian capital of Erfurt. Enjoy a guided tour of the medieval city centre. Spend a free afternoon exploring as a group.

DAY 7 / Weimar **B D**

Enjoy a full-day excursion to the thousand year old city of Weimar. Learn about the town's many famous citizens throughout history on a guided tour. Spend a free afternoon in the city centre. Return to Erfurt in the early evening.

DAY 8 / Leipzig **B D**

Depart Erfurt for Leipzig. Enjoy a guided tour of the city in the morning. The afternoon is free for you to explore Leipzig further as a group. Visit one of Europe's oldest coffee houses, now a coffee museum, or the magnificent Altes Rathaus, which dates back to the Renaissance period.

DAY 9 / Dresden **B D**

Travel to Dresden and spend a free morning exploring the city. Known as the German centre of Baroque, Dresden is home to both architectural and artistic masterpieces. Enjoy a guided tour in the afternoon.

DAY 10 / Dresden **B D**

Enjoy a paddle-steamer cruise on the Elbe River this morning. Spend a free afternoon in the city, exploring the Royal Palace or one of the city's 30 museums.

Transfer to Germany's capital, Berlin. Visit the Checkpoint Charlie Museum. Enjoy a free afternoon in the city.
